Colonel Ted Nurse joined the Regiment in the spring of 1963. He has served in every officer rank from Second Lieutenant to Lieutenant Colonel when he commanded in the period 1981-1983.

He also served in the RCD as a Battle Captain, HQ 4CMBG as an SO3 and at the Armoured Corps School as OC Tactics Squadron.

His last Corps related appointment was as a Colonel when he served as the Project Director of the New Tank Program from 1987-1989.

Outside of the Corps, he served as Base Administrative Officer at CFB Petawawa, and as a DS and later the Director of Army Studies at the Canadian Forces Command and Staff College. He commanded CFB Toronto and held the position of Director of Project DELEGAAT at NDHQ.

Colonel Nurse is a graduate of the Canadian Forces Land Command and Staff College, The Canadian Forces College and the US Joint Staff College. He completed his BA at the University of Manitoba and an MA (History) at York University.

His post-military employment includes an attachment to the Privy Council Office during the Somalia Inquiry as a technical advisor to the Chairman and prior to retirement in 2007 he was the CEO of the Kingston and Region Division of the Canadian Corps of Commissionaires.
